Course Schedule:

This course is open to anyone interested in "Introduction to Chinese Medicine." No prior background in Chinese medicine or medical studies is required — just curiosity and an eagerness to learn!

Course Fees:

Tuition: NT\$5,000

Registration Fee: NT\$300 (for new students)
